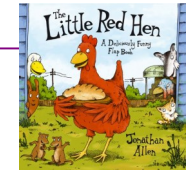
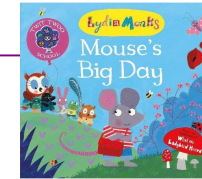
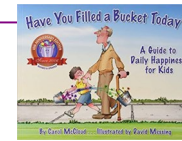
Literacy

In Literacy we will be starting the excellent Read, Write Inc programme. We will be learning to 'Fred talk' to help us to segment and blend words and well as beginning to learn the sounds that some letters make. We will also be exploring the stories Mouse's Big Day and books about people who help us. These will help us to explore the feelings we have when we start school and will also find out about the adults in our community that help us every day. We will also explore the story of The Little Red Hen and non-fiction books about farming.

Topic

We will begin this term by getting to know each other and share how amazing every child in the class is. We will be exploring our setting and learning the class and school rules. The we will be learning about food form farm to fork. This will include planning and growing food to eat and learning about bread with the help of The Little Red Hen.

Numeracy

Once baseline assessments have been completed our focus for maths will be sorting in different ways, making comparisons and finding rules for sorting. We will also be subitising, exploring number patterns, counting and finding 'more than' and 'fewer than'.

Key vocabulary
