### Welcome Back!


I hope that you all had a wonderful Christmas and New Year.

# Vocabulary and background knowledge:

mantle	A portion of the earth between the crust and the core
magma	Extremely hot, liquid rock
Tectonic plates	The earth's crust is made up of large plates that join together
pollution	Anything introduced into a habitat that is harmful to living things
Water vapour	Heat from the sun evaporates water into water vapour
evaporate	When a liquid turns into a gas or water vapour
condensation	A gas cools and changes to a liquid
estuary	Where a river meets the ocean
tributary	A small river or stream that joins a bigger river
current	The strength and speed of a river
vertebrate	Animals with a <u>back bone</u>
invertebrate	Animals without a <u>back bone</u>
