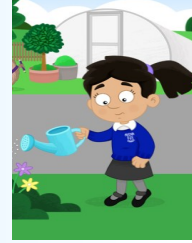

In addition to this, please read the book sent home at least 3 times a week, even if it's only a couple of pages. This book matches your child's reading level and should be decodable for them. If you find they are reading it too easily or if it is too hard, please email us to let us know. It should become easier to read after the second read and fluency and pace can then be improved. Record this reading in your child's Reading Record, along with the date and an encouraging comment for them. Don't forget....Children always love it when parents read to them as well!

Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather—wellies and raincoat or sun cream (applied before school), sun hat and extra drinks.
