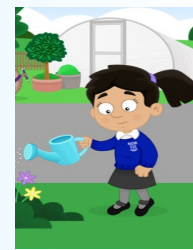

Welcome Back!

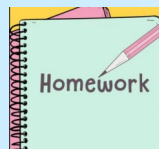
We do hope that you all had a wonderful Easter break. It is difficult to believe that it is the final term of the school year—time really does fly!
