I do hope that you all had a wonderful Easter break.

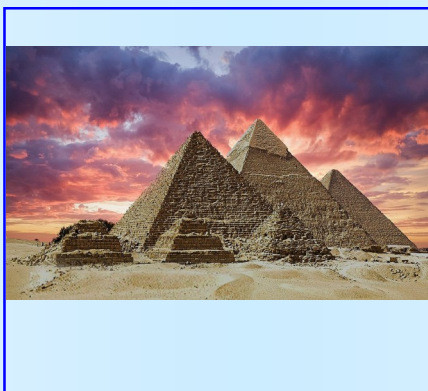
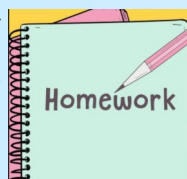
This term, we will be starting a brand new History topic which is all about the Ancient Egyptians.

Throughout the term, the children will also be learning about the main parts of flowers and exploring the different functions each part has as well as looking at the requirements for plant life and growth. Children will also be given the opportunity to explore different animals including the amount of nutrition they need to survive. We will also look into how some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

In DT the children will be looking at a variety of different Ancient Egyptian masks and ornaments so they can design and create their own. Then in art the children will be looking at creating their own sculptures using different materials and techniques. This is going to be a brilliant unit of work and one I am sure will be enjoyed by all!
