MAIN DRIVER:	TOPIC DESCRIPTION:
	During this tonic children will learn all about the ancient civilisation of Fount, whilst discovering the treasures of ancient tombs and exploring the lives of archaeologists

MAIN DRIVER.	During this topic, children will learn all about the ancient civilisation of Egypt, whilst discovering the treasures of ancient tombs and exploring the lives of archaeologists and Pharaohs. Crucial to this topic is learning about the pyramids and how the incredible life-giving River Nile had such an impact of the lives of the Egyptians. Children will explore what life was like, what the Egyptians believed about the after life and how the other ancient civilisations fit into our world history.

Science NC	Light: recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light/ notice that light is reflected from surfaces/recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes/recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object/find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.
	Sound:
	Pupils should be taught to:
	 identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
	• find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it
	 find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
