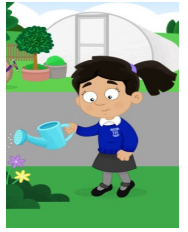

Drop off and Collection

As per the guidance issued in July, we are maintaining a staggered start and end to the school day based on surnames just to ease congestion both in and out of school. Please do try and stick to these times wherever possible

Arrival 8.50 Collection 3.20

Reception and Year 1 have separate entrances at the front of school and all other classes arrive and depart via the main school gate where a member of the Senior Leadership Team will be present.

From Thursday 4th until Friday 12th September, the Reception class will leave at 2.15pm.

Naming Property

Please try to ensure all your child's property is clearly labelled. This is the best way for missing items to find their way back to their owners. This also includes snack boxes, water bottles and plates and we suggest that these are checked regularly as they can wash off.
