



Reception Homework

As your child progresses through the Read Write Inc Programme they will bring home a sound book, sound blending books then book bag books. This is in addition to their bedtime story. Children should ideally read every night for at least 10 minutes from their Read Write Inc books/green and red words, then enjoy sharing their bedtime story. They are not expected to be able to read their bedtime story but they may be able to read some words with you in this book.

In terms Autumn 1 and 2 your child will have sounds homework. This is to practice the sounds that they have been learning that week. As they progress, they will also receive reading books.

From the Spring term there will also be a termly project related to our topic. A template will be provided for your child to complete. It will include a note on what we expect the children to be able to do. This project should be done as independently as possible with praise and encouragement from you. They may need to talk about their project with the class so talking about what they have done or discovered would be a great help.

Sounds homework will go out on a Friday to be returned on the following Thursday.

Project homework will be handed out at the beginning of the term and will include a hand in date.
