## Termly topic projects

Each half term, the children will be given a project based on their current topic. It will either be a creative or research project and should promote independent learning.

## On-going home learning

### Reading

Please support your child with their reading at home and write in their reading records what pages they have read and any comments you feel may be useful.

If your child is on the Read, Write, Inc. programme they will regularly bring home 'red' and 'green' words to practise and a paper copy of the book that they have been reading in their RWI sessions. This is in addition to their weekly decodable book and a choice of book from Starbooks. Some children will be receiving short extracts from books to be practised each night at home, ready for a 'performance read' on Thursdays.

### Spelling

In Year 2 we have daily spelling lessons where we learn two new words a day which follow various spelling rules. We practise these at school so there is not a requirement to learn them at home. There is however a list of Year 1 and Year 2 words that your child is expected to be able to read and spell by the end of Year 2. These can be practised as and when at home throughout the year.

## Maths

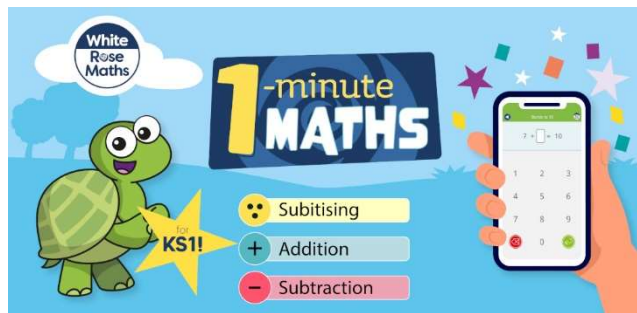
