



## Expectations for homework Year 3



### Reading

**Fluency Homework-** Every Monday, there will be a brand new fluency text coming home with your child. Please practise re-reading the text **aloud**. Practising every day will really improve their reading but a minimum of **3 times per week** is required. This text will need to be returned to school **every Friday** so that we can continue our comprehension session on this text.

If your child can quickly get into a routine for practising this text regularly, it will make such a difference to your child's reading. Get used to checking your child's bag on a **Monday** and please let me know if your child isn't bringing it home every week.

**Reading for pleasure-** Your child will have a reading for pleasure book from our Star Books library. They will need to have this book with them every day. Reading every day for a small amount of time is ideal but a minimum of 3 times per week is required. Your child will be able to change this book when they wish to and is encouraged to bring it back if they aren't enjoying it. Your child will be encouraged to develop skills that will help them make good choices about the books they have and suitability for their age but ultimately, this book needs to be read for enjoyment.

I will monitor your child's reading regularly so that we can work together to ensure that they are reading books that they want to read and are choosing books that are appropriate for them. Please don't hesitate to come and speak to me if your child is not wanting to read at home and then I can support with this.

### Maths

**TT Rock Stars-** Children are required to practise their times tables for a minimum of 3 times per week. The times tables set will change through the year as different times tables are taught. The target times tables for Year 3 are x2 x5 x10 x3 x4 x8.

**Optional-**There are paper copies of times tables grids and TT Rock stars tests available for those who wish to practise their skills further. The children can choose these as and when they need them.

**Optional- Daily Ten-** this is a free online game which is brilliant for times tables, especially when your child is learning a new times table. It is also useful for other basic Maths skills. Check it out using the link below:
