Each week your child will be given a **reading task and pages to complete in their arithmetic workbook**. Please see the information below to find out more information. If you have any questions, please contact me and I will do my best to help.

Reading homework will vary from week to week. Tasks will range from reading fluency to reading comprehension and research linked to the wider curriculum. All work will be set in your child's Book of Books.

Reading fluency – This will include a text in your child's Book of Books. We would ask that your child reads the text to an adult at home who can **make a comment on how they performed the text**. It would be fantastic to see comments not just from parents, but other family members and friends that your child chooses to share their reading with. The text will be something they have already rehearsed in class, so they should feel confident to read it aloud at home with little support.

Reading comprehension – Your child will receive a text with questions to answer. The more independent they can be with this, the better. The aim is to provide opportunities to see what your child can do on their own and then we will explore the questions together in class after they hand it in.

Wider curriculum research – Your child may be set a short task to research an area linked to our History, Science or Geography work. Instructions will be provided with task so that children know what they are expected to do.

Arithmetic – We provide a CGP Arithmetic workbook for your child. Please ensure they take good care of this book as they will use it for several weeks. Page numbers to complete will be circled and bookmark tabs provided so that pupils know which pages they need to do each week. If your child struggles with any work set, we are happy to help them if they let us know before the hand in date.

As we want to promote independence and responsibility, we ask that homework is completed every week and handed in on time. Please encourage your child to organise their time to complete work set.
