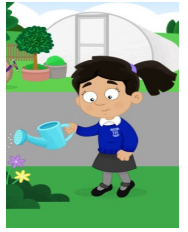

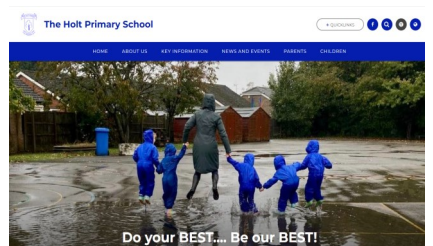
## New Website
