The class will have Synergy coaching for PE on a Tuesday morning and a Wednesday afternoon.

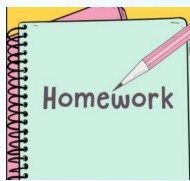
Term 3 will be dance and golf followed by tennis and basketball in term 4.
