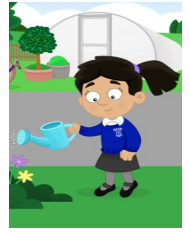

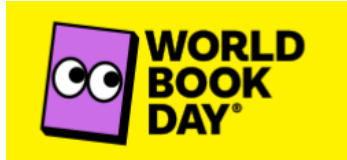

## Sponsored Pancake Flip
