## Assessments

Over the next few weeks, we will be undertaking the national curriculum assessments across school as follows:

- Year 6 Key stage 2 SATs 11th-14th May
- Year 1 Phonics screening 8th—12th June
- Year 4 Multiplication Check 1st—12th June

Your child's class teacher will be able to answer any questions you have. Year 2 Key stage 1 SATs are no longer statutory and the children will complete these papers when other year groups do their end of year assessments in June.
